# 1 MBF token creation


MiniApps supports **Skype** and **Facebook** channels via **Microsoft Bot Framework** (MBF). If you are going to use one of those channels, you need to connect MBF first.

Firstly, register your bot in MBF. Go to the [MBF bot registration page](https://dev.botframework.com/bots/new) (<https://dev.botframework.com/bots/new>) and perform the next steps:

## 1.1 Fill bot profile

Fill in the **Bot profile** part. All the fields marked by "\*" symbol are mandatory. By clicking on the question mark on the right side of the field name, you will get a hint with a description.

Next up is **Configuration**. To fill in the fields click on the **Create Microsoft App ID and password** blue button:

## 2 MiniApps bot configuration

Please pay attention to the next steps, which describe how to connect newly created MBF profile to our MiniApps bot.

Log in to MiniApps (<https://dev.miniapps.run/private/my-bots>). You will see your MiniApps bots list. Select the required one. For example:

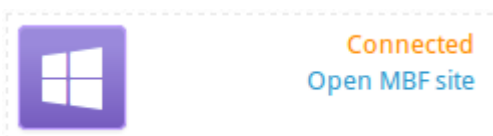
